

### About the Program

Help your customers take advantage of the benefits of a high efficiency HRV with the *HRV Rebate Program*. Homeowners are able to receive a \$175 rebate available on approved models. High efficiency units also save about \$1,000 on energy costs over the unit's lifetime.

### Program Technical Specifications

Qualifying HRVs must meet the following criteria:

- Efficiency rating of 70% (SRE) at 0 degrees.
- 63% SRE at -25 degrees.
- Fan efficacy of 1.2 cfm/watt.
- If the SRE is 75% or higher, the efficacy can be 0.8 cfm/watt.

### Installer Certification

HRV units must be installed by a Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Institute (HRAI) certified installer. This is the only certification recognized by the HRV Rebate Program. <http://www.hrai.ca/>

### How a Homeowner Receives the takeCHARGE HRV Rebate

- Purchase a qualified HRV and have it installed by a HRAI certified installer.
- Complete the HRV rebate application form available at takechargenl.ca or to receive a copy in the mail call Newfoundland Power at 1-800-663-2802 or Newfoundland & Labrador Hydro at 1-888-737-1296.
- Submit an application and a copy of the receipt to the utility. The rebate will be shown as a credit on the homeowner's electricity bill within eight weeks.

### Homeowner Rebate Program Eligibility

- You are the homeowner and the home has an active electricity account.
- Your home is detached, attached or mobile/modular on a permanent foundation and intended as a residence.
- Your home can qualify regardless of heat source or age of home.
- HRV must be purchased on or after September 15th, 2013.
- HRV must be a qualified unit and installed by a HRAI certified installer. A list of qualified models and certified installers is available at [takechargenl.ca](http://takechargenl.ca). If you have chosen not to be included on this list, you can verify your certification with your HRAI wallet card.
