

Winsulation 2022 Monthly Draw:

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

- To be eligible to enter and win a Prize, you must be a resident of Newfoundland and Labrador. You are not eligible to enter or win a Prize if you are an employee of Newfoundland Power or Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (the Sponsors), their affiliates and related companies, advertising or promotional agencies or a member of the immediate family of such employee (defined as parents, siblings, children and spouse, regardless of where they live). To be declared a winner of a Prize, your home and project must meet all current eligibility criteria for the takeCHARGE Insulation Rebate Program including:
 - a) You are the homeowner and the home has an active electricity account.
 - b) Your home is on a permanent foundation and intended as a residence.
 - c) Your primary source of heat may be electric ("electric customers") or oil ("oil customers"). If your primary source of heat is electric and an additional heating source is used, your home must have a minimum annual electricity usage of 15,000 kilowatt hours (kWh). If your primary source of heat is oil, your home must use at least 1,000 litres of oil annually. A copy of a current annual statement that shows a minimum of 1,000 litres of oil consumption must be included with application.
 - d) Your home must have been built and connected to the electricity system prior to January 1, 2014
- Only insulation required to complete the insulation project is eligible for the rebate. The insulation must meet R-Value requirements:
 - a) Minimum R18 to maximum R25 for basement and crawl space walls.
 - b) Minimum R30 to maximum R35 for basement and crawl space ceiling.
 - c) Minimum R50 to maximum R55 for attics.
- The rebate applies to pre-tax insulation costs. Other materials and labour will not be reimbursed. You may add to existing insulation to reach the recommended R-value, but rebates will not be provided to replace existing insulation.
- The Prize will be awarded for basement/crawl space walls or basement/crawl space ceiling insulation upgrades, but not both, and for attic insulation upgrades.
- No purchase necessary. Customers not eligible for the insulation rebate, or having already completed an insulation upgrade may enter the Contest and be eligible for an alternate Prize by submitting a 500-word essay explaining why energy efficiency is important to you, and what you are doing in your home to be energy efficient. Only one entry per household is permitted for the Contest duration. Value of the alternate Prize is equal to a \$600 credit towards another eligible energy efficient product or products included in the suite of takeCHARGE residential programs.
- There will be six grand prizes in total. On the first weekday of each month from November 2022 to January 2023 inclusive, two grand prizes will be drawn: one for electric customers and one for oil customers.
- There will be a single early bird prize randomly drawn from entrants on November 1, 2022.
- There will be monthly secondary prizes drawn on the first weekday of each month from November 2022 to January 2023 inclusive.
- Insulation must be purchased after September 22, 2022.
- Only one prize per household is allowed.
- Issuing of prizes is contingent on eligible entries being received.
- Newfoundland Power and Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro may visit your home and inspect the insulation upgrade at any time within 15 months from the date the rebate is processed.

HOW TO ENTER: Customers who purchase insulation after September 22, 2022, apply for the insulation rebate, and are approved for a rebate are automatically entered in the monthly draws. The Contest period runs from September 22, 2022 to December 31 2022. There will be one draw on the first weekday of each month for the grand prizes and secondary prizes, with all non-winning entries submitted after September 22, 2022 being eligible to win in each subsequent draw.

PRIZES:

The grand prize is an on-bill credit of the amount necessary to increase the rebate to which the grand prize winner is entitled under the terms of the takeCHARGE Insulation Rebate Program as stated above such that the grand prize winner receives a total amount, including the takeCHARGE rebate, equal to 100% of the pretax cost of insulation materials required to insulate the grand prize winner's home to R-Value levels outlined in the Insulation Rebate Program (a "100% Rebate") or, where the grand prize winner is not a participant in the takeCHARGE Insulation Rebate Program, a \$600 credit towards another eligible energy efficient product or products included in the suite of takeCHARGE residential programs. Maximum rebate is \$1,500 for attic insulation and \$1,500 for basement insulation. The odds of winning a grand prize in the Contest will depend upon the number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period. Grand prizes are awarded by random draw from entries received. Only one winner per household is allowed.

In addition to the six grand prizes, there will be a single early bird prize as well as monthly secondary prize winners. The early bird prize will consist of a pre-card credit card valued at \$250. The early bird prize will be awarded by random draw from entries received by October 31, 2022.

The random draw for the early bird prize will occur on November 1, 2022. The secondary prizes will consist of pre-paid credit cards valued at \$100. The secondary prizes will be awarded by random draw on the first business day of each month beginning in November from among all oil and electric rebate entries submitted during the contest period. There is a limit of one monthly secondary prize winner per household. The winner of the early bird prize and the winners of the monthly secondary prizes will have their names re-entered for subsequent draws for a grand prize. The odds of winning the early bird prize or a secondary prize will depend on the number of eligible entries received during the contest period.

PRIZE CLAIM(S): To be entered to win a Prize, you must apply by mail or online at TakeChargeNL.ca for the insulation rebate. To be declared a winner of a Prize, you will be required to state your name, mailing address and date of birth and to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question, to be administered by phone. If an entrant does not correctly answer the skill-testing question in the time allotted, the Prize will be forfeited and may be awarded to an alternate entrant.

RELEASES, ETC.: Before being declared a winner of a Prize, a selected entrant will be required to sign a Release of Liability form, which (among other things): (i) confirms compliance with these Official Contest Rules; (ii) acknowledges acceptance of the applicable Prize as awarded; (iii) releases the Sponsor, its advertising and promotional agencies, parent companies and affiliates of the foregoing and all of their respective directors, officers, owners, partners, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns (collectively, the "Releasees") from any and all liability in connection with the Contest, (iv) requires each entrant to agree and consent to the publication, reproduction and/or other use of their name, address, voice, statements about the Contest and/or photograph or other likeness without further notice or compensation, in any publicity or advertisement carried out by or on behalf of the Sponsor in any manner whatsoever, including print, broadcast or the internet.

PERSONAL INFORMATION: By accepting a prize in the Contest, entrants agree to the publication, reproduction and/or other use of their name, and city/town/community without further notice or compensation, in any publicity or advertisement carried out by or on behalf of the Sponsor in any manner whatsoever, including print, broadcast or the internet. By accepting a Prize, winners consent to the collection, use and disclosure to the public of their names, addresses (city, province/territory), voices, statements and photographs or other likenesses for publicity purposes in connection with the Contest in any media or formats including, but not limited to, the Internet, without further notice, permission or compensation. Personal information will not otherwise be used or disclosed without consent.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY: Without limiting the generality of provisions set forth elsewhere in these Official Contest Rules and Release of Liability, and for greater certainty, the Sponsors/Releasees will not be liable for: a) any incomplete or inaccurate information, b) any typographical or other errors in the offer or administration of the Contest, including but not limited to errors in advertising, these Official Contest Rules, the selection (if applicable) and/or announcement of eligible winner(s), and/or the distribution of any Prize(s); and/or e) any combination of the above. Newfoundland Power and Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro will not honour product or installation warranties or guarantees, and are not responsible for any damage caused by the installation of any product. Entrants acknowledge and agree that they shall have no recourse to any court and shall have no remedy available in law or equity for any damages which may be related in any way to this contest.

RIGHT TO TERMINATE, SUSPEND OR AMEND: Sponsors reserve the right to terminate, amend or suspend the Contest, in whole or in part, without prior notice to any person.

MISCELLANEOUS: Claimants who have not complied with these Official Contest Rules are subject to disqualification from the Contest. All decisions of the Sponsors are final and binding without right of appeal in all matters relating to the Contest. The Sponsors will not be responsible for illegible, incomplete, lost, misdirected or late Prize claims, all of which will be void.
