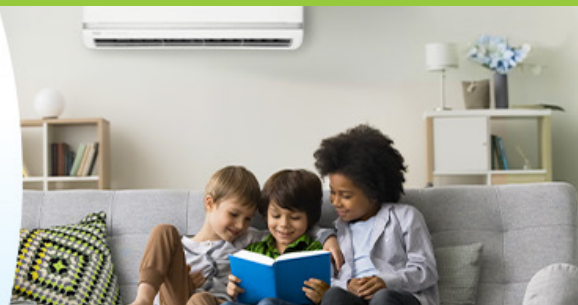

## Oil <sup>to</sup> Electric Incentive Program



This is a pre-approval application. All applicants must receive a pre-approval from takeCHARGE to be considered for an incentive.

### Step 1: Eligibility

- You have an oil or propane heated home.
- You are the home owner and the home has an active electricity account.
- You meet income eligibility. See final page of application for income chart.
- Your home must be on a permanent foundation, intended as a primary residence in Newfoundland and Labrador, and used year-round. New homes are not eligible.
- Your home must be connected to the island or Labrador's interconnected electricity grid.
- Only projects completed after April 1, 2023 are eligible.

### Step 2: Required Documentation

- Quote from a participating installer. Quote must include technology model number(s), electrical costs, labour and materials.
- Picture of oil tank HOST tag. The HOST tag number can be found on the small brass tag attached to the tank's vent pipe.
- Picture of oil tank Serial number. The Serial number is located on the tank's data plate or stamped directly on the tank.
- A statement or copy of all oil receipts from your oil company for a **consecutive 12-month period** within two years of your application date that shows a minimum consumption of 500 litres of oil.
- A statement or copy of all propane receipts from your propane company for a **consecutive 12-month period** within two years of your application date that shows a minimum consumption of 1,500 litres of propane. (Propane heated homes only).
- Before an incentive can be issued, a participating installer is required to submit a before and after picture of the oil tank, a before and after picture of the electrical panel, after picture of the new technology installed and other eligible expenses such as electricity panel box upgrade.

☐ Participants of this program will be automatically enrolled in possible future residential demand response programs facilitated by the Utilities, with an opt-out provision available to customers that do not wish to be enrolled. Participants of the demand response program will be provided networkable thermostats, often referred to as "smart" thermostats. The Utilities will contact the customer prior to the start of any new programs they are to be enrolled in, to confirm participation and provide further details.
