# **Eligibility Requirements**\*

- Your **primary source** of heat is electric. If an additional heating source is used, your home must have a minimum annual electricity usage of 15,000 kilowatt hours (kWh).
- Your home was built and connected to the electricity system before January 1, 2014.
- Your home is on a permanent foundation and is intended as a primary residence.
- You are the homeowner and the home has an active electricity account.
- If you have received a rebate for insulation from another rebate program, your takeCHARGE rebate may be prorated to ensure you do not receive a total rebate greater than 100% of your pre-tax material purchase.
- A participating professional installer must install spray foam insulation.
- To qualify for a **rebate on labour costs**, your project must be completed by a participating professional installer.

### **About R-Values**

- R-Value measures how well certain insulation materials can resist heat movement. The higher the R-Value, the more effective the insulation.
- Different materials have a range of R-Values that can be combined to achieve a higher R-Value rating.
- All types of CSA-approved insulation with a verifiable R-Value are eligible.

### Insulation Type and R-Value

Batt: R12 to R40 with R3 to R3.7 per inch Rigid Board: R3.6 to R5 per inch Loose Fill Blown-In: R3 to R3.7 per inch Spray Foam: R3 to R6 per inch

# **Insulation Requirements**

- The R-Value must meet the minimum requirements listed in the chart after the insulation is installed.
- Rebates are only available for the insulation required to complete your project.
- Only eligible insulation products with a qualifying purchase receipt will be rebated.
- The rebate applies to pre-tax insulation and labour costs. Other materials (e.g. vapor barrier, studding, etc.) are NOT rebated.
- · Rebates will be paid for basement and crawl space wall upgrades, or basement and crawl space ceiling upgrades, but not both.
- You may add to existing insulation to reach the required R-Value, but the rebate does not include the replacement of existing insulation.
- For attics without existing insulation or where the existing insulation required replacement, rebates will be calculated with a starting R-Value of R20.

# **Project Information**



## Step 1: Measure

Measure the space to determine eligibility and rebate amount, including the existing insulation depth for attics, as this is what will be used to calculate your eligibility and the amount of your rebate. Aim for 16"-19" (R50-55 range) or R60 maximum in Labrador.



# Step 2: Purchase

Ensure purchased insulation covers the space and meets the required depth or R-Value. Check brand specifications and consult contractors or building supply staff to ensure your measurements are correct. The receipt must detail the number of bags purchased, brand, R-Value, and square footage of purchase. This is used to calculate the amount of insulation required for you to receive a rebate.



#### Step 3: Install

Purchase insulation locally and install it yourself, or purchase and install it through a hired participating professional installer. Refer to TakeChargeNL.ca for installers and instructional videos.



## Step 4: Apply for the Rebate

Apply for the rebate only after installation is complete. Fill out the application and include a copy of purchase receipts. Make sure your receipts clearly separate the costs for materials and labour associated with your project. Mail it to the utility that issues your electricity bill or apply online at TakeChargeNL.ca.
